

Why more boys then girls have autism?

Boys inherit one X-chromosome from their mother and one Y-chromosome from their father.

"If a boy's X-chromosome is missing the PTCHD1 gene or other nearby DNA sequences, they will be at high risk of developing ASD or intellectual disability.

"Girls are different in that, even if they are missing one PTCHD1 gene, by nature they always carry a second Xchromosome, shielding them from ASD. While these women are protected, autism could appear in future generations of boys in their families."
